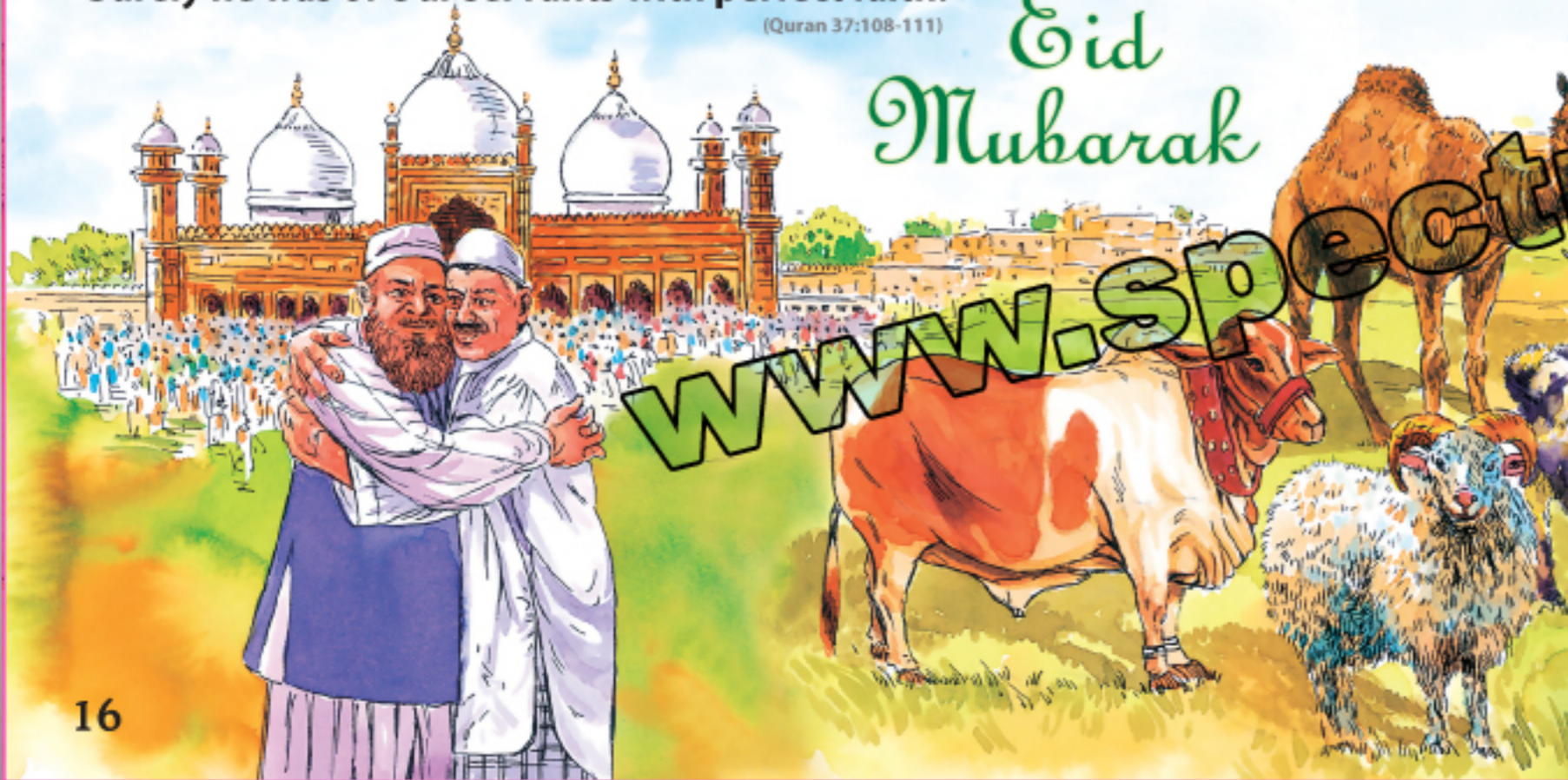


Allah Almighty has made this sacrifice a ritual, for all time to come and turned this into a day of EID for all Muslims.

Every year on the day of Eid-ul-Adha Muslims slaughter sacrificial animals in the name of Allah Almighty and in remembrance of Hazrat Ibrahim عليه السلام . Our beloved Prophet Muhammad ﷺ has said, "For those who slaughter sacrificial animals will get Sawab in proportion to the number of hair these animals have on their body coverage. (Sunan at-Tirmizi)

Every rich and wealthy person is required to slaughter sacrificial animals.

The animals should be of sound health. Sacrifice should only and only be held in the name of Allah Almighty.

To arrange sacrifice just as a show-off does not entail any Sawab.

At the time of sacrifice, it is obligated that there is no laughter and entertainment, But recite Takbeer and supplicate"
